### **Haverhill – Salvation Army**

Provides services that include food pantries, rent payment assistance, electric bill payment assistance (in December), gas bill payment assistance, utility payment assistance, Christmas baskets, Thanksgiving dinner and prescription.

Each year, The Salvation Army provides a full **Thanksgiving** lunch to any member of the Greater Haverhill Community.

Applicants are required to bring: Photo ID, proof of ALL household income, proof of expenses (rent/mortgage, utilities, etc.), proof of address in Haverhill, Bradford, or Groveland, Proof of all household members via ID for adults and birth certificates for children.
