

Nutrition Program

The federally funded Nutrition Program offers a well-balanced meal to adults through home-delivered services and congregate dining sites. Meals are more than just a hot lunch. Drivers ensure a daily visit offering a warm smile, a kind word, and a well-being check.

SERVICES

Meals meet 1/3 of the daily USDA standards and are available in Regular, Renal, Cardiac, Modified, Chopped, Ground, Low Lactose, and Pureed for all home-delivered meals clients. Chinese and Latino home-delivered meals are available as well.

ELIGIBILITY

The Home Delivered Meal Program serves adults age 60 and older or qualified adults who are determined to be homebound and unable to prepare a balanced meal or safely participate at a Congregate Dining Site. Any adult over the age of 60 may participate at the Congregate Dining Site.

COST

There is no cost for either the home delivered meals or congregate meals, however,

a \$2 meal donation is suggested. Donations directly support the provision of meals to hundreds of older adults in the community every day and are anonymous and voluntary. No eligible person will be denied service based on income of the ability to donate.
