Service

AgeSpan's Power of Pets program is a support initiative that helps older adults (age 65+) afford veterinary care so they can keep their pets healthy and at home.

The program provides up to \$200 in one-time financial assistance per year for veterinary care for pets of those in need.

If you already have a veterinarian, AgeSpan will pay your vet directly, up to \$200. If you do not have a veterinarian, AgeSpan will help coordinate services with an approved vet.

Services Covered:

- Spaying/neutering expenses
- A variety of inoculations
- Flea/tick care
- Annual checkups
- Nail trimming
- Other routine care
- Rabies shots

Eligibility

- People currently receiving AgeSpan services, such as:
 - Meals on Wheels, home care or those living in community housing
- People 65 and over, not using our services, who qualify financially (Example: \$1,882 monthly income for a single-person household)
- Must reside in the Merrimack Valley or North Shore.
